## TAMPA CHAPTER MOAA STANDING POLICIES

LUNCHEON RESERVATIONS: Reservations are required and must be made no later than the date and time specified in the Retrospect. Members who fail to attend are responsible for the lunch fee and will be billed.

DRESS CODE: During periods when Standard time is in effect, proper attire for men is jackets, with or without tie, or military uniform. During periods when Daylight Saving time is in effect, proper attire is business casual (slacks/shirts with collars). Proper attire for the Christmas luncheon is coat and tie or military uniform. Ladies are requested to dress appropriately for the season.

DUES: Annual dues are set by the Board of Directors. Dues for new members who join after July 1st \$15.00. New members who join after October 1 will be considered paid through the following year. Active duty members enjoy free membership.

MEMBER PRIVACY: The membership directory is for personal use only. No commercial use of the directory is authorized.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT: The Chapter will obligate funds for non-chapter functions at the discretion of the President with approval of the Board.

NEWSLETTER: The monthly newsletter, The Retrospect, is available on the chapter website. The President may authorize additional distribution.

SCHOLARSHIPS: The Chapter may award up to six annual scholarships for pursuit of post-secondary education and training to children or grandchildren of current members. The Board appoints the Selection Committee who establishes the requirements and qualifications with the approval of the Board.
